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Comedian Bob Marley returns to Sugarloaf

Bob Marley is coming to Sugarloaf. No, not the dreadlock sporting Rasta man, but Maine's very own King of Comedy, who claims at the time of his birth his father had no idea about the singer.

Marley will bring his hilarious and one-of-a-kind show to the Shipyard Brew Haus again this year on February 17 and 18.

The comedian got his start in the comedy business in Portland and Boston and eventually moved to Los Angeles where he shared his witty observations and high energy with the west coast. A graduate of the University of Maine at Farmington and a long time Sugarloafer, Marley studied Community Health, but his real talent was discovered at a stand-up comedy night he did for fun. Since then he's had people rolling in the aisles for fifteen years, and once again calls Maine home.

Marley has made numerous appearances on television, making it onto all the late night shows, "The Late Show" with David Letterman, "The Tonight Show" with Jay Leno, "Late Night" with Conan O'Brien and "The Late Late Show" with Craig Ferguson and Craig Kilborn, and countless appearances on Comedy Central.

In 1999 Marley landed a role in the cult hit *The Boondock Saints* as the bumbling detective Greenly, and in November of 2009 made a reappearance as Greenly in the sequel *Boondock Saints II: All Saints Day*. He is a regular at the Montreal and Aspen comedy festivals, and regularly tours Los Angeles, Chicago, Boston, Washington D.C., and New York. Hailed by *Variety* as one of the "top ten comics to watch", Sugarloaf and The Shipyard Brew Haus are proud to welcome Marley back to his old stomping grounds.
