homes or businesses connected to the utility grid;

\* For solar electric systems installed after Jan. 1, 2007, the system must be installed by a master electrician who is North American Board of Certified Energy Practitioners certified, or by a master electrician working with someone who is NABCEP certified; and, List of NABCEP Certified Solar Electric Installers.

Maine's Wind Energy Rebate Program

Efficiency Maine has also reinstated the rebate program to install small wind energy systems. Rebates up to \$2,000 will be available for qualified resident wind systems that meet the program requirements, under the rules adopted by the Maine Public Utilities Commission in accordance with the recent statutory changes. Qualified applications for the new wind incentive program will be

awarded on a first come, first serve basis. If after the first quarter demand appears to be on track to exceed available funding. Then a random selection system will be instituted.
