Annalivia to play Rangeley, South Carthage

SOUTH CARTHAGE & RANGELEY — New England Celtic Arts will host the dynamic Boston Based acoustic quintet "Annalivia" at Skye Theatre Performing Arts Center in South Carthage on Wednesday, March 25, and at the Lakeside Theater in Rangeley on Thursday, March 26 with the concerts starting at 7 p.m. at both theaters. A pre-show jam will start at 6:15 at Skye Theatre; bring your instruments and join in. Reservations are strongly suggested at both venues.

Annalivia is one of the latest hip young alt-traditional bands to emerge from the potent Boston fiddle music scene. The acoustic quintet features the beautiful voice of Liz Simmons, a protégé of famed Irish singer Karan Casey. Fiddle champions Brendan Carey Block and

Emerald Rae, guitarist/vocalist Flynn Cohen, and bass player/banjo picker Stuart Kenney joins Liz. Together, their music combines Anglo-Celtic ballad singing and fiddle music traditions with their North American counterparts—Appalachia and Cape Breton—all with a groove-centric contemporary flair.

Pianist Eric Himy to perform at UMF

FARMINGTON — Pianist Eric Himy will present a program of Gershwin, Debussy and Liszt on Saturday, March 28, at 7:30 p.m., at Nordica Auditorium in Merrill Hall on the University of Maine at Farmington campus on Main Street.

The New York Times has described Himy's playing as "flawlessly poised, elegant and brilliant." His compelling artistry has intrigued audiences around the world. His technique has been compared recently by the 2007 Revue Musicale de Suisse Romande to that of the legendary pianist Vladimir Horowitz finding him "a sensual gourmand of sound."

He received his Masters of Music from the Juilliard School and in December 2007 two of his recordings, Mozart and Schumann, were picked by BBC Music Magazine as CD of the month. Himy was invited by the Bernstein family to celebrate the 90th anniversary tribute to Leonard Bernstein in a Gala concert at the 2008 Lukas Foss Music Festival in the Hamptons.
